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TOEFL Test Preparation

BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE

This course is for students at an upper-intermediate to advanced level of English proficiency, planning to attend a U.S. college, become U.S.-certified in a profession or wishing to improve their academic skills in English. All areas of the TOEFL are addressed: listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing. This course covers test-taking strategies and prepares students for the computer-based "Test of English as a Foreign Language." **Prerequisite:** A 20-minute academic reading test and an interview with the ESL Advisor.
