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Introduction

Executive Summary.

Business Intelligence and Data Analytics works closely with Institutional Effectiveness at Montgomery County Community College (College) to provide the College's Factbook on an annual basis. The information provided is meant to serve as a tool for the College's employees, students, alumni, and the community that it serves.

As a data resource, the Factbook provides tables and charts representing institutional characteristics, enrollment, and performance metrics. Five-year data trends are included to provide added institutional context. The data in this Factbook is categorized by fiscal year (July 1 to June 30).

The metrics provided in this Factbook aid the College in assessing the Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) of the 2023-2027 Strategic Plan. The pillars of the plan are to:

- Ensure Student Learning,
- Enhance Employee Experience, and
- Expand Community Participation.

The Factbook, 2023-2027 Strategic Plan, and the KPIs are all made available to both the internal and external College community and illustrate the College's continued focus of transparently sharing assessment and evaluation results.

The Factbook is divided into four sections: Enrollment Trends, Student Demographics, Dual Enrollment, and Student Success Metrics. The outlined areas below provide narrative highlights for the data in each section.

Enrollment Trends

- In fiscal year (FY) 2024, there was an enrollment increase of 5,000 total credits over FY2023.
- The Health Sciences, Liberal Arts, and STEM Divisions all experienced an increase in total credits.
- Regarding credits by modality, online asynchronous was the modality with the highest number of credits at 78,000 with face-to-face instruction following at 64,000.
- Unduplicated headcount increased in both the fall and spring semesters but was flat overall for FY2024.
- Continuing education, which includes anyone who took a continuing education course, saw its second lowest unduplicated headcount within the last five fiscal years.
- Full-time equivalent (FTE) increased by almost 200 for a total of 5,712.68.

Student Demographics

- Average class sizes increased at both the Blue Bell and Pottstown campuses as well as within our online learning platform.
- Unduplicated student populations by degree type, associates, dual enrollment, and non-degree all saw increases, while certificate students decreased when compared to the prior fiscal year.
- Duplicated student populations by degree type were consistent with unduplicated student populations. The exception to this during FY2024 were certificates which saw a three-fold increase for this degree type. This is most likely the result of students being able to concurrently achieve a certificate and an associate degree.
- Student populations by age group remained relatively stable with any fluctuations for the age groups being less than 1%.
- The average age by campus and fiscal year also remained stable.
- Male students saw the largest increase from 5,848 in FY2023 to 6,205 in FY2024. Female students increased from 8,628 in FY2023 to 8,827 in FY2024.
- Overall, there was an increase in the number of students who identified themselves as racially and/or ethnically diverse. This increase was almost 2% from 43.46% in FYE 2023 to 45.39% in FY2024. Correspondingly, there was an almost 2% decrease in the number of students who self-identified as Caucasian.

Dual Enrollment

- The unduplicated count of Dual Enrollment students (students in traditional dual enrollment as well as the Gateway to College, Upward Bound, and Gear Up programs) has steadily increased for each fiscal year since 2020 with a high of 2,659 in FY2024.
- The total number of Dual Enrollment credits also increased over the last five fiscal years to a high of 15,448 in FY2024 with the high schools being the course location with the highest number of credits (10,003).
- Students aged 17 and 18 were enrolled at the highest percentages, 36.18% and 41.52% respectively.
- FY2024 also saw the highest number, 348, of Dual Enrollment students who then went on to take a minimum of one MCCC course after their high school graduation within the last five fiscal years.

Student Success Metrics

- Overall, the total number of degrees and total number of graduates remained stable from FY2023 to FY2024 with an almost identical degree count and a small increase in the graduated student count.
- Successful course completion was at 74.00%, which is the highest rate within the last five fiscal years.
- New degree seeking student retention, from fall to spring, was at its second highest rate since FY2020 at 71.99%. The earlier highest retention rate was 73.49% in FY2020.
- New degree seeking student retention, from fall to fall, decreased slightly from 55.89% in FY2023, which was the highest rate in five years, to 54.04% in FY2024.

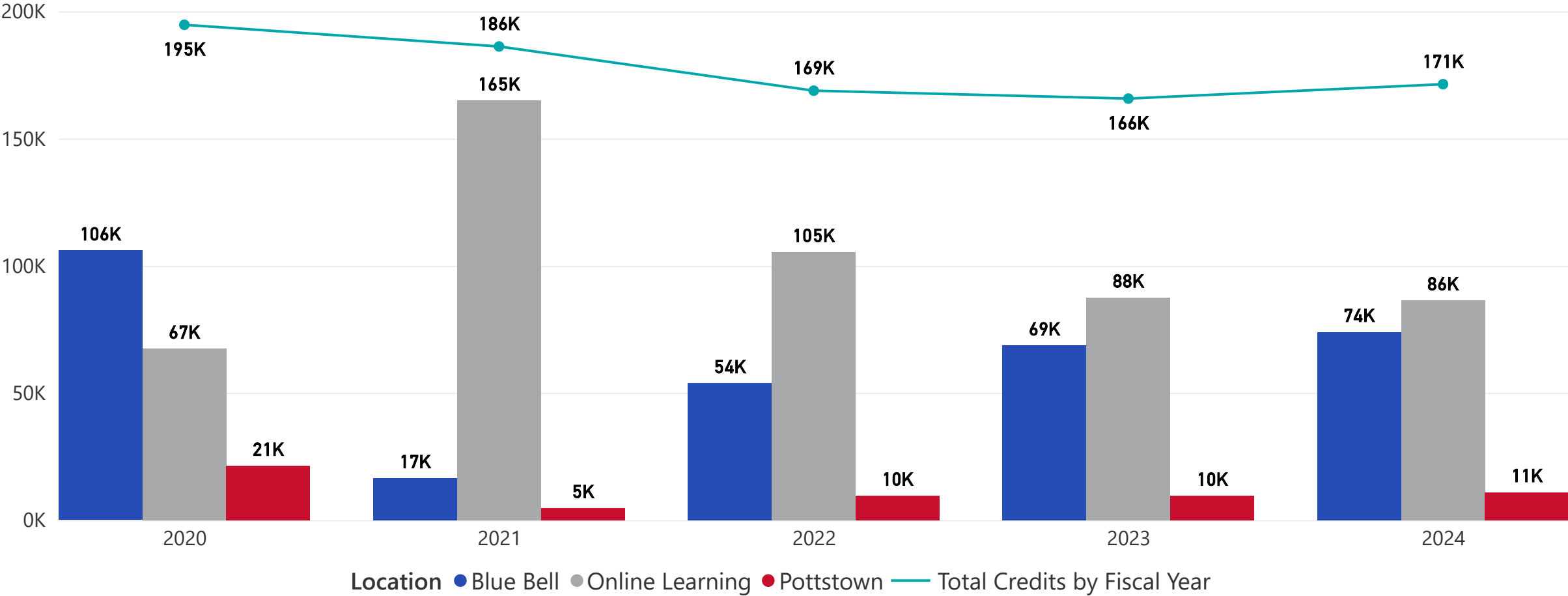

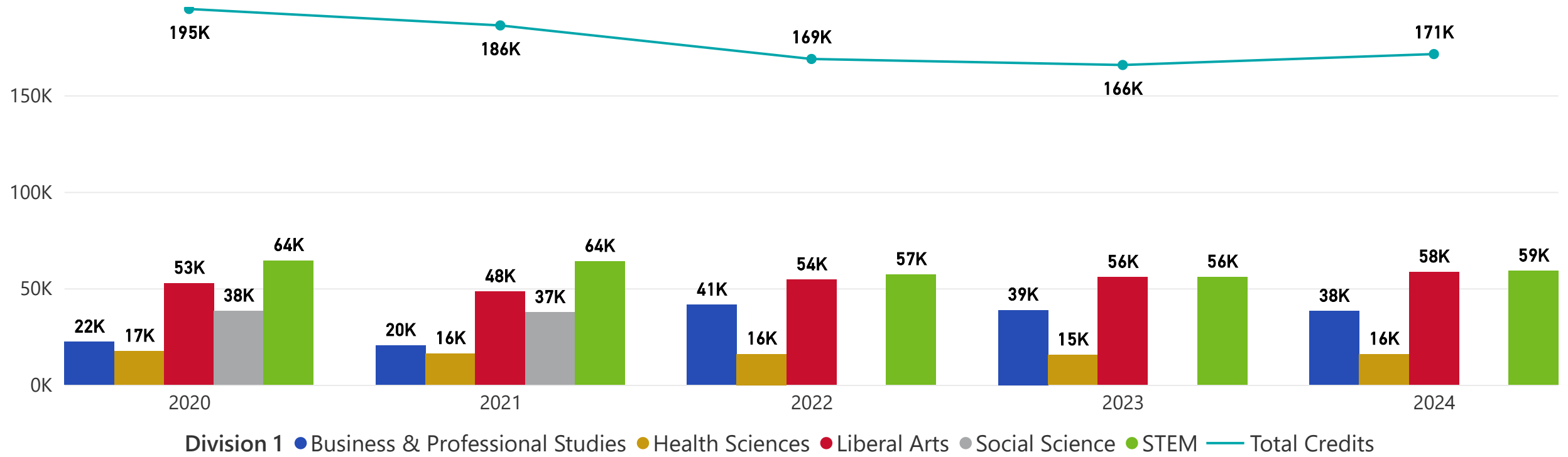

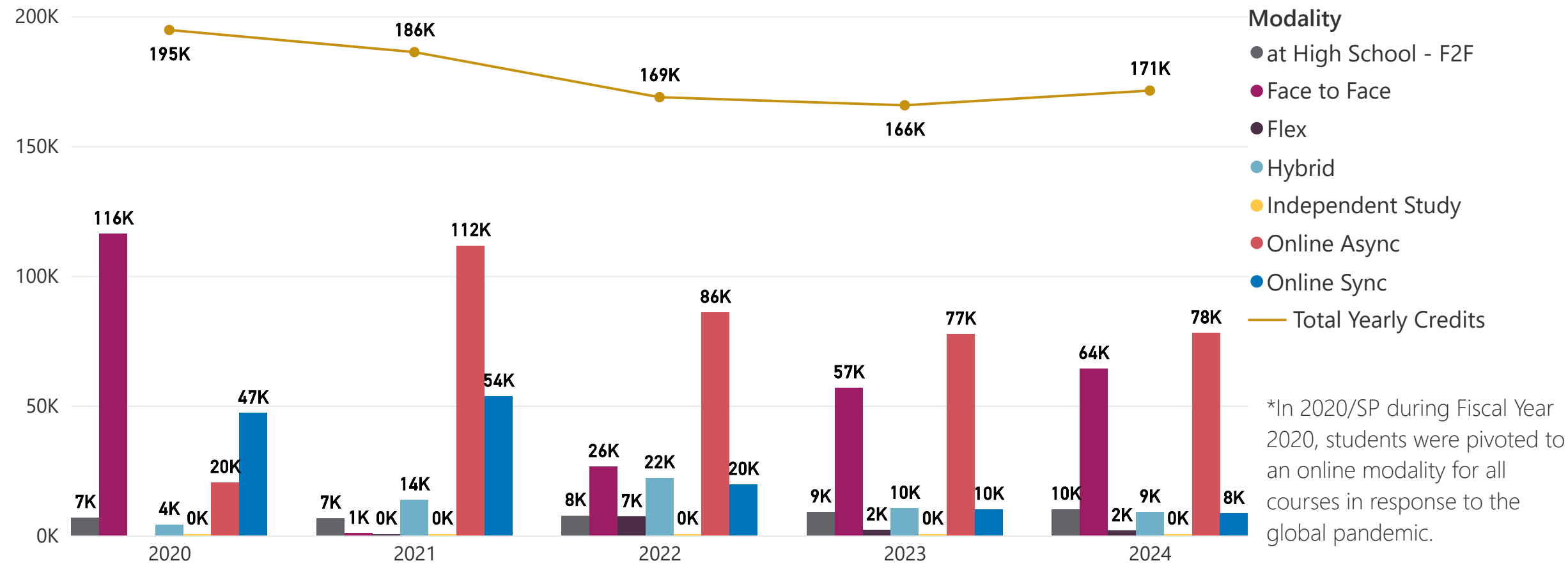
Total Credits by Division and Fiscal Year

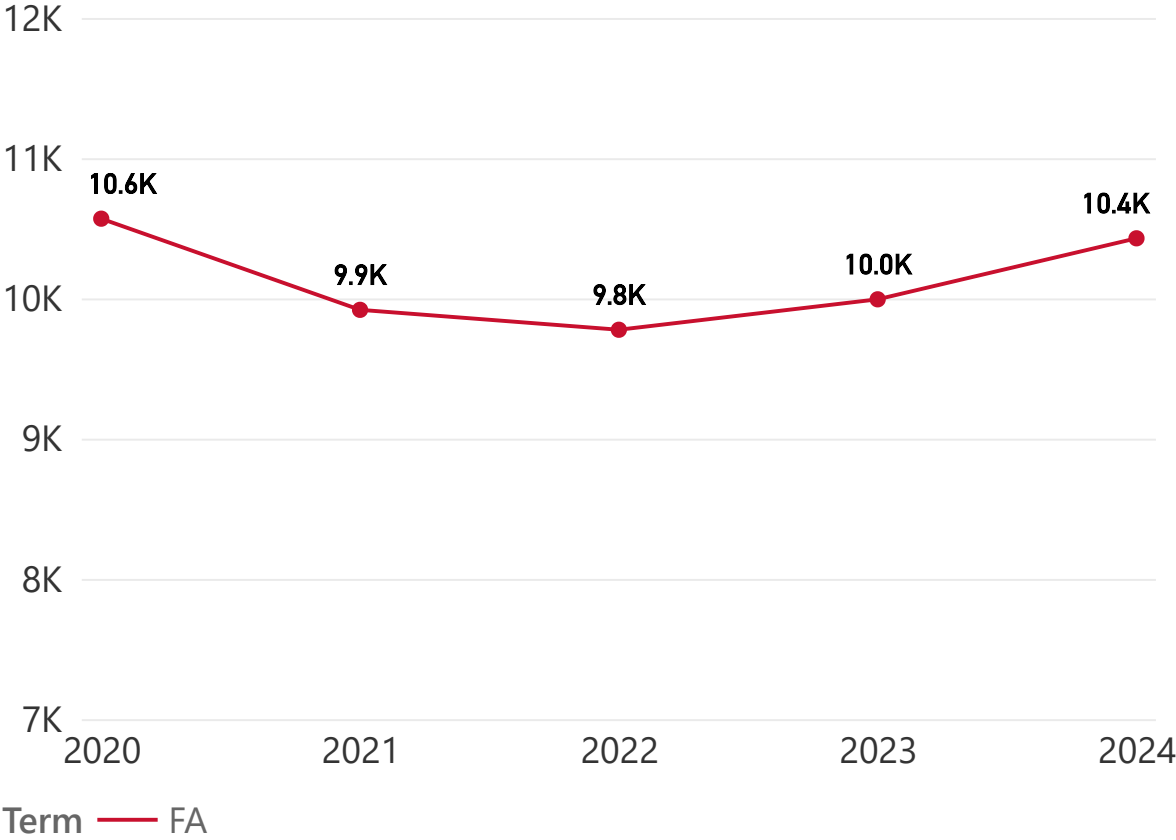

Total Credits by Modality and Fiscal Year

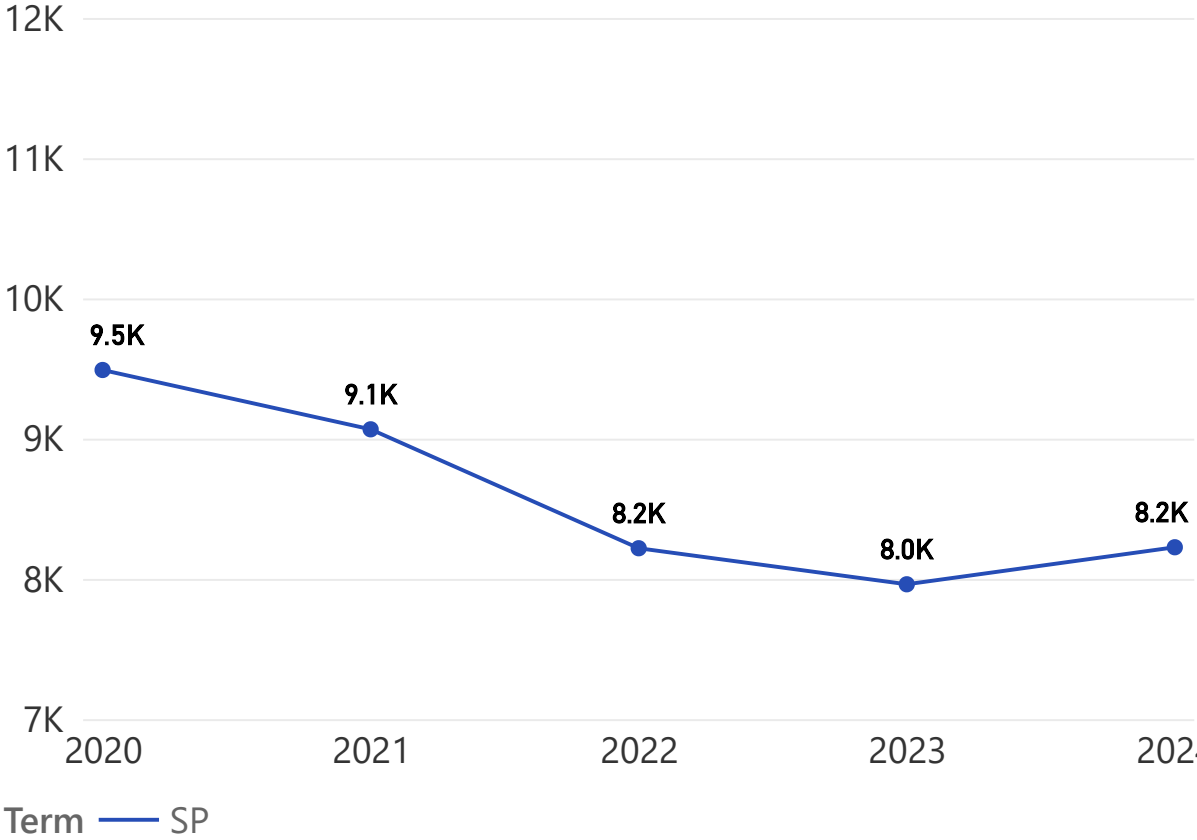

Unduplicated Headcount by Fall Term



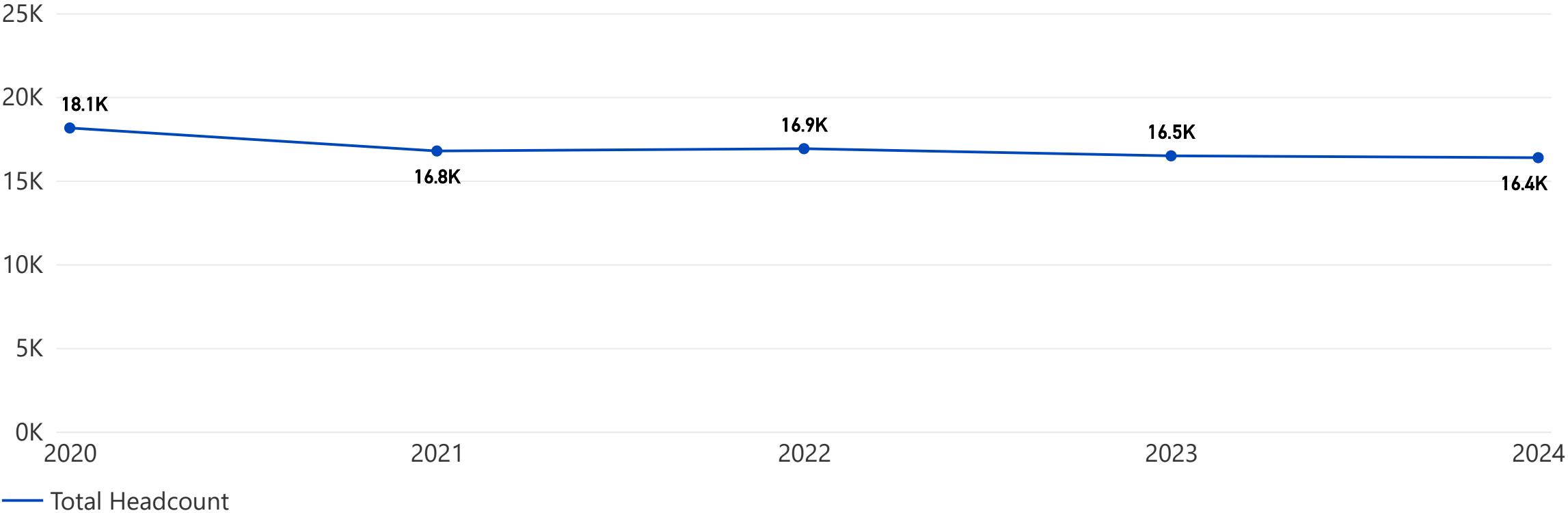
Unduplicated Headcount by Spring Term

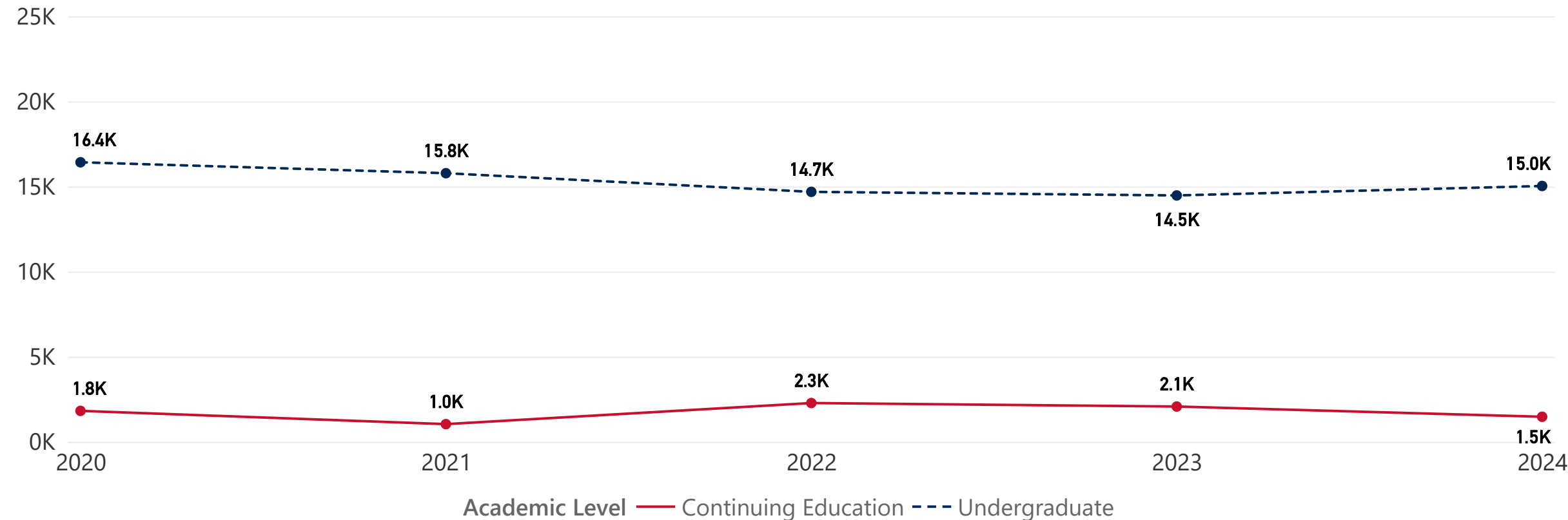
Unduplicated Total Headcount by Fiscal Year

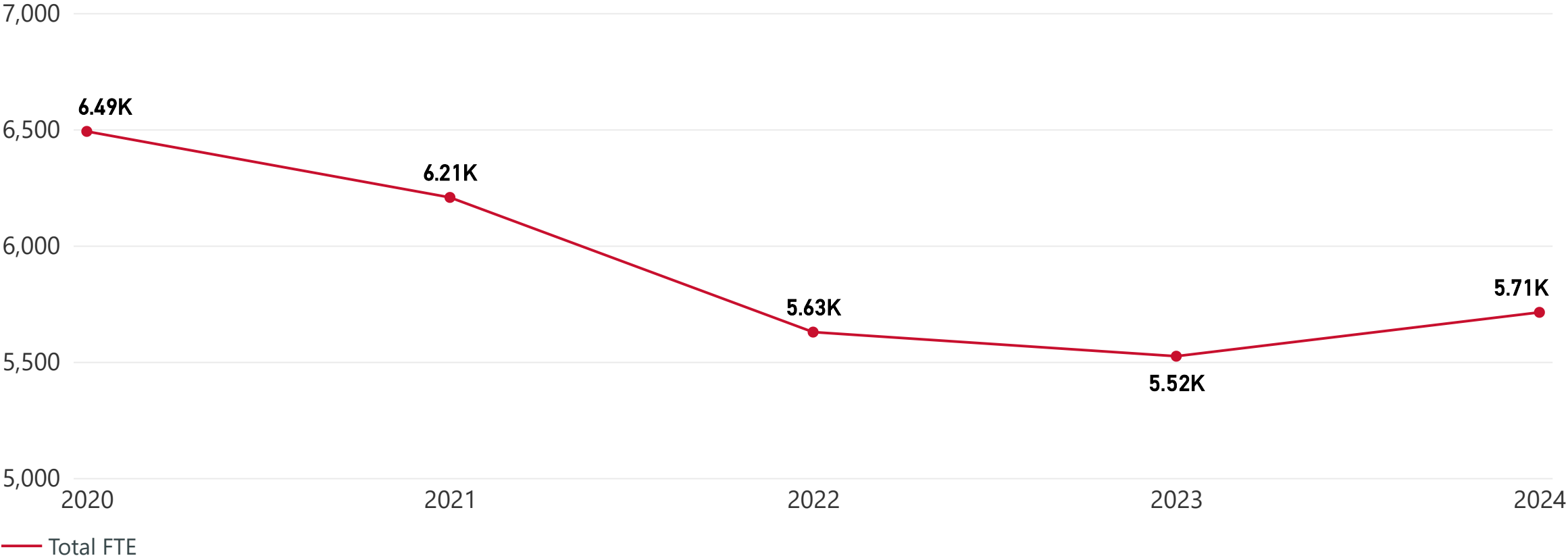

Total Full Time Equivalents (FTE) by Fiscal Year

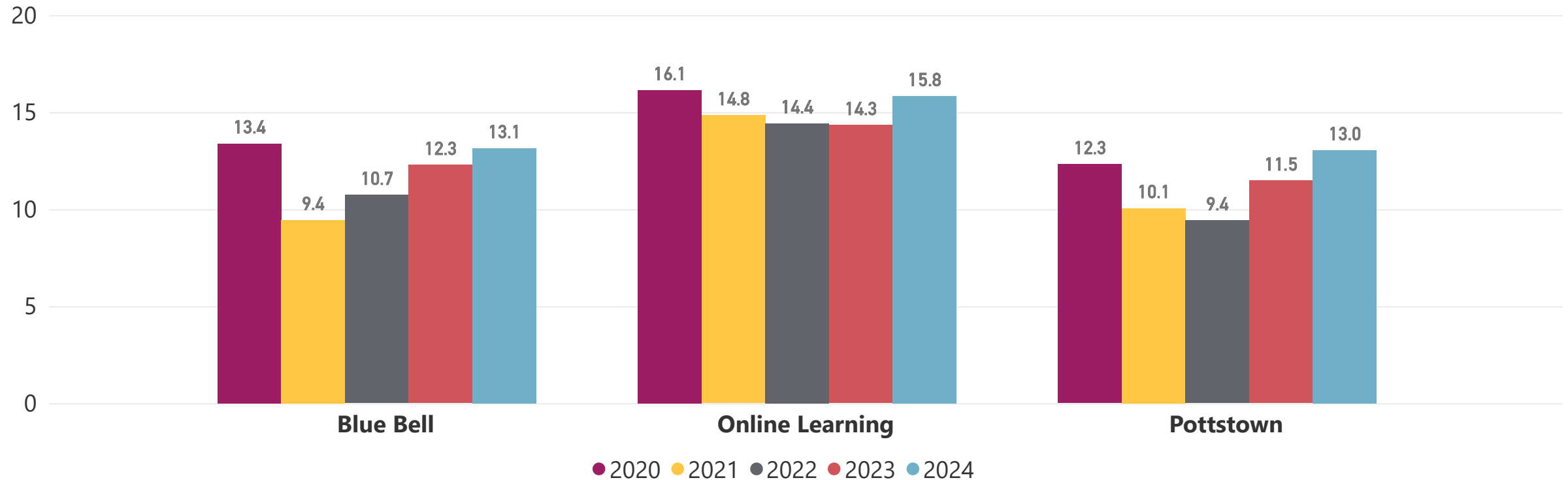

Average Class Size by Location



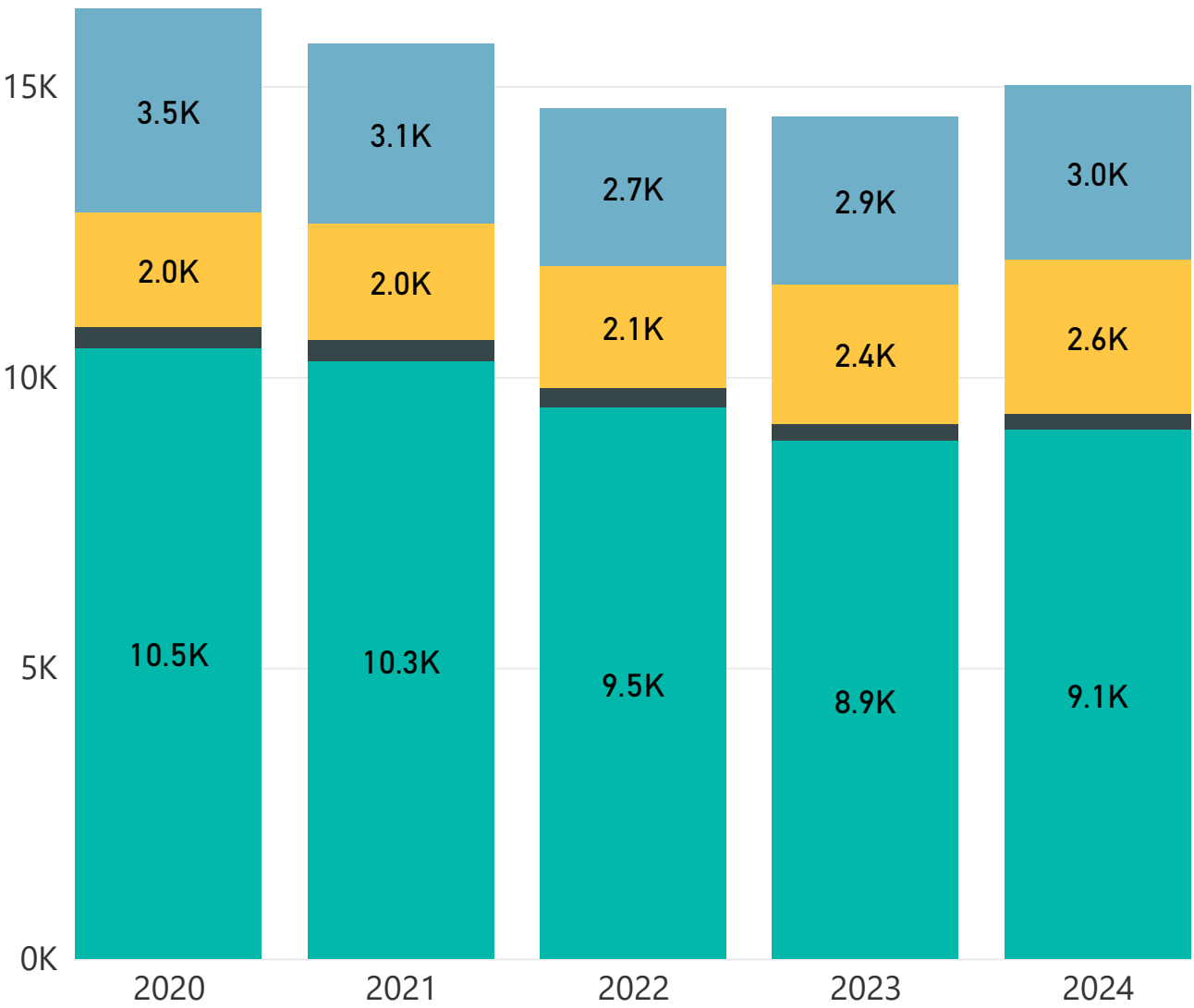

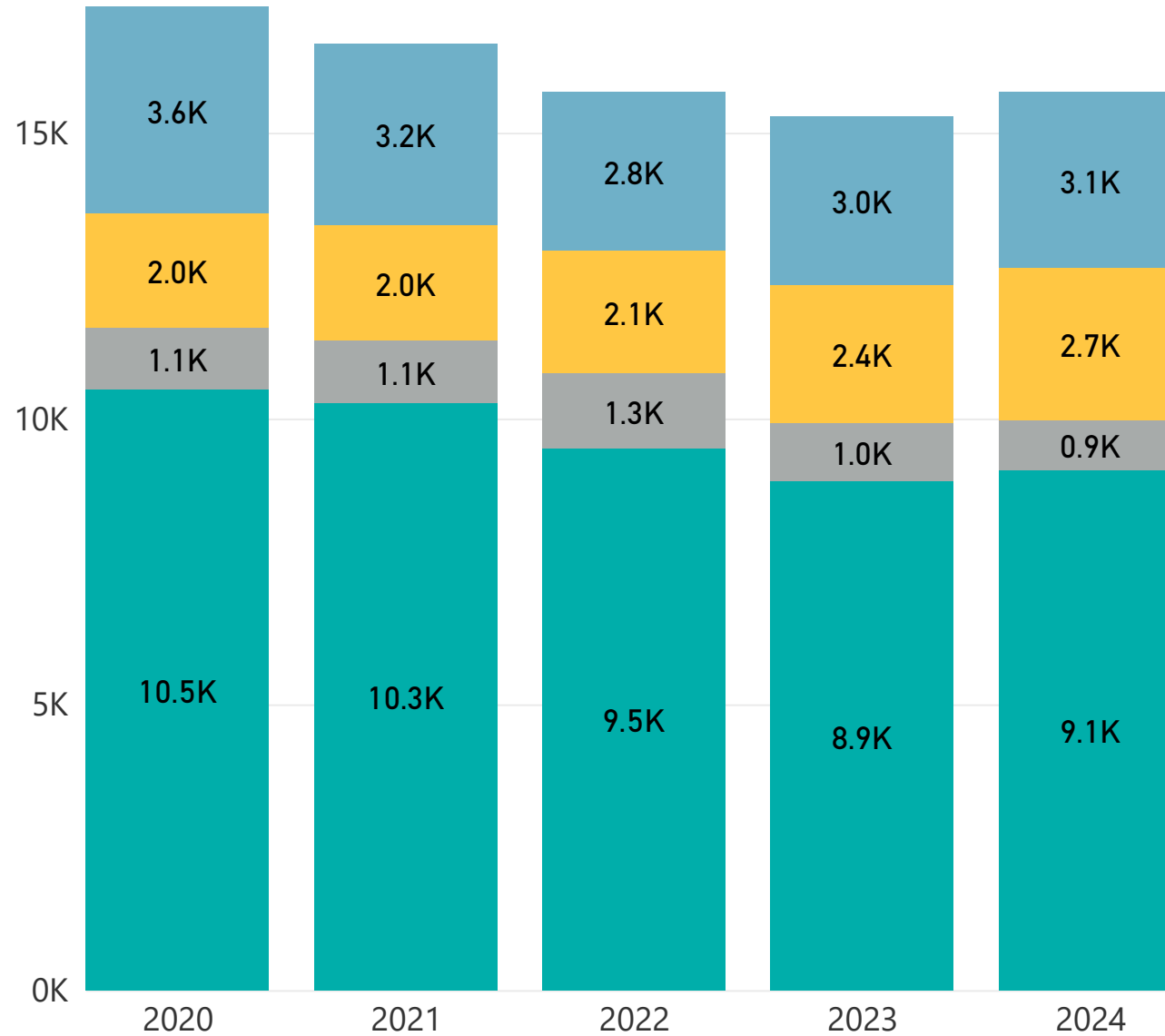

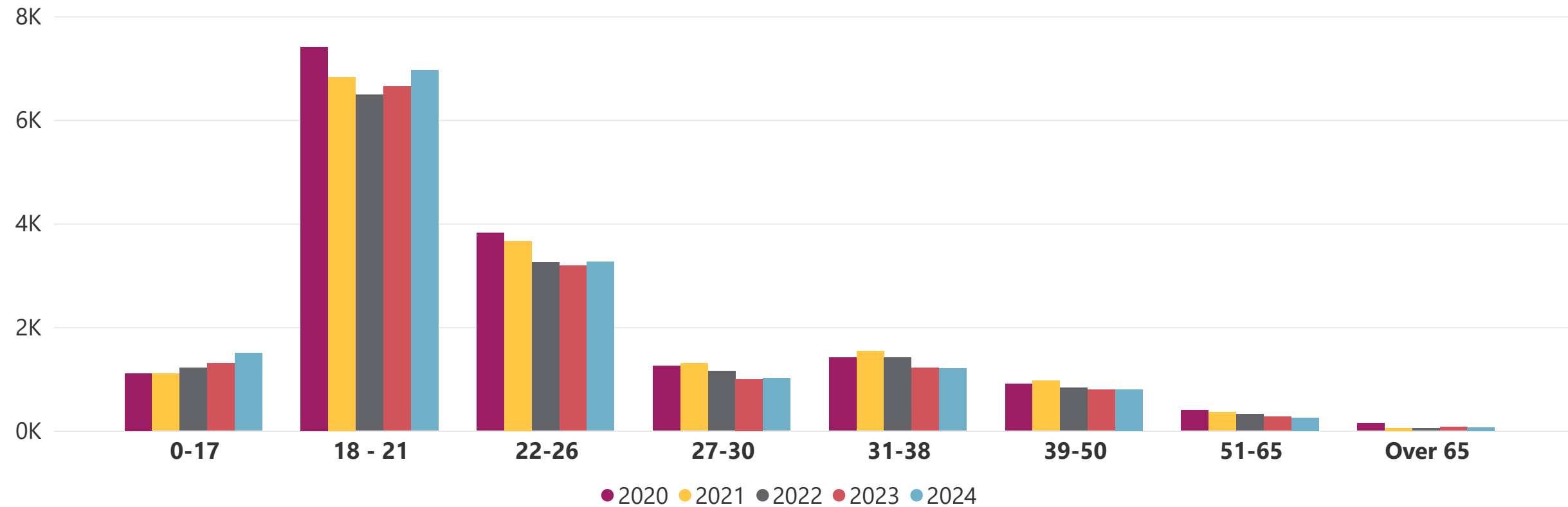

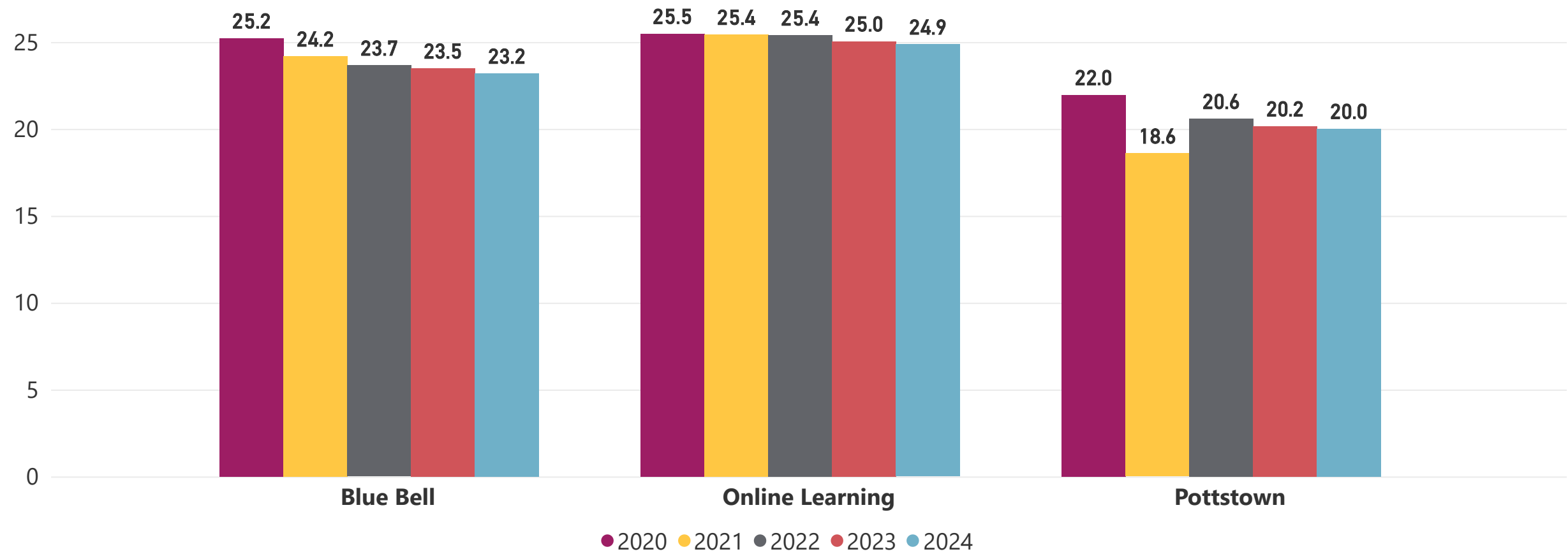

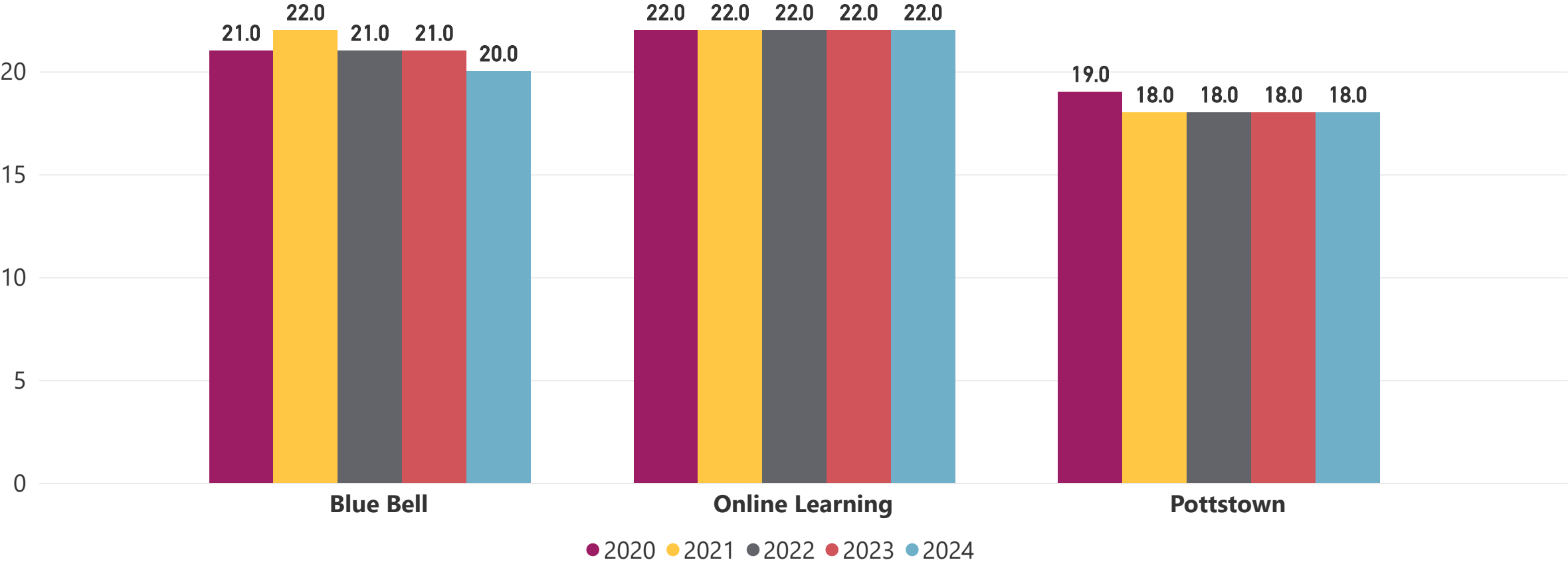

Median Age by Location and Fiscal Year

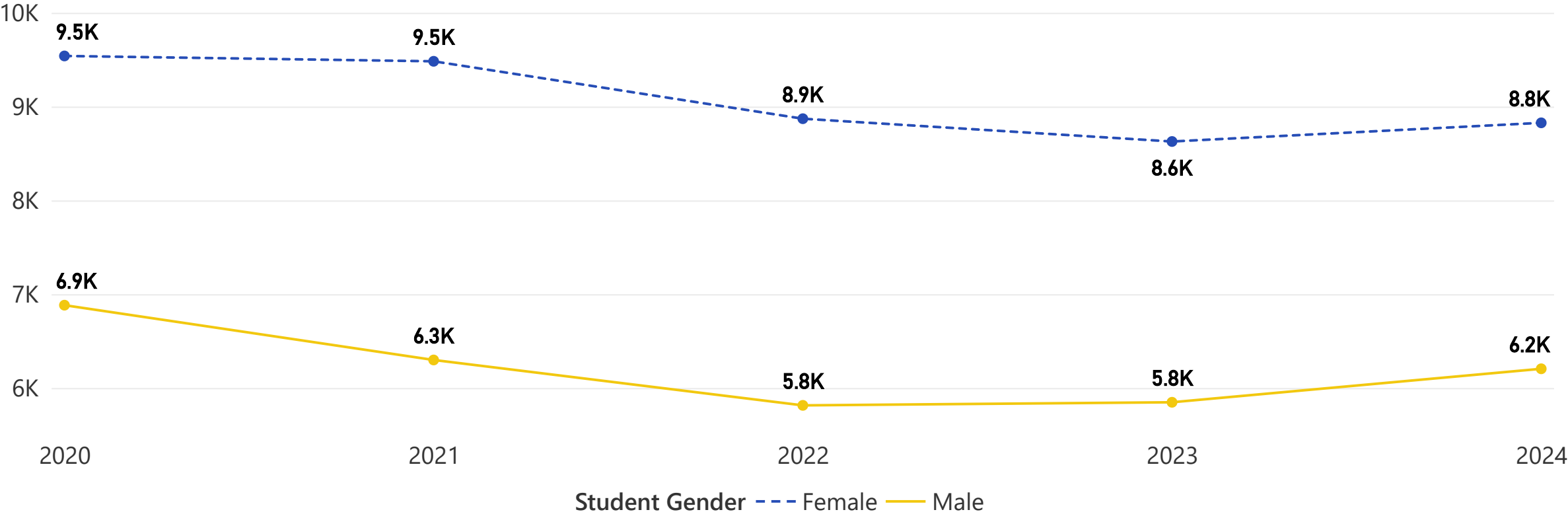

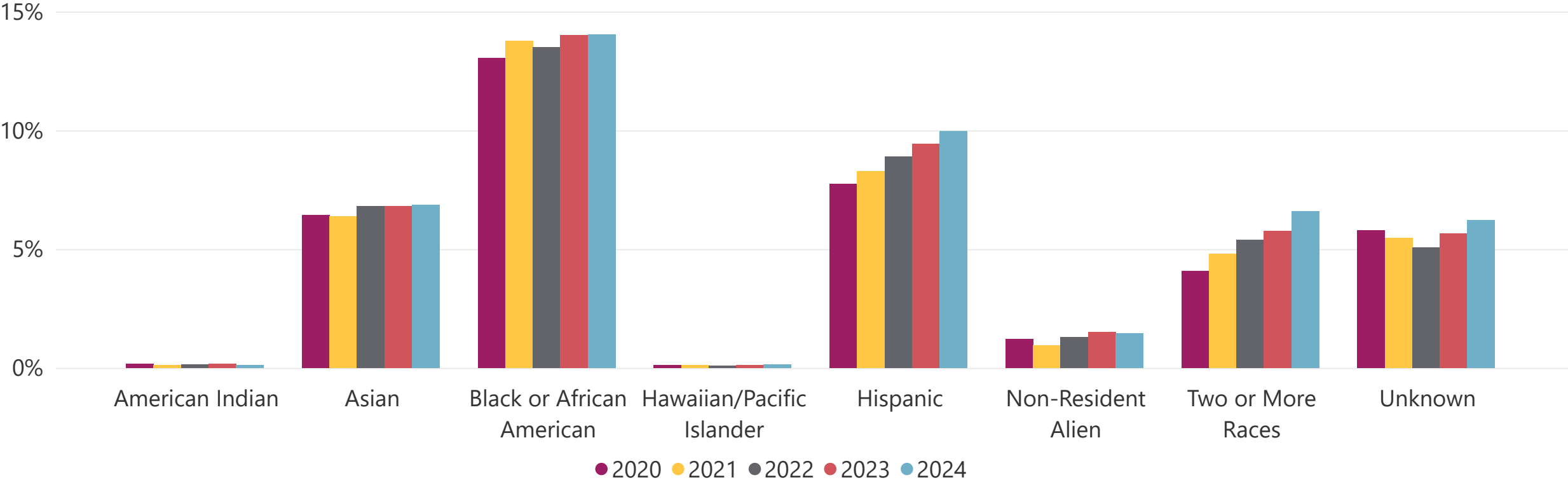
Student Population by Gender and Fiscal Year

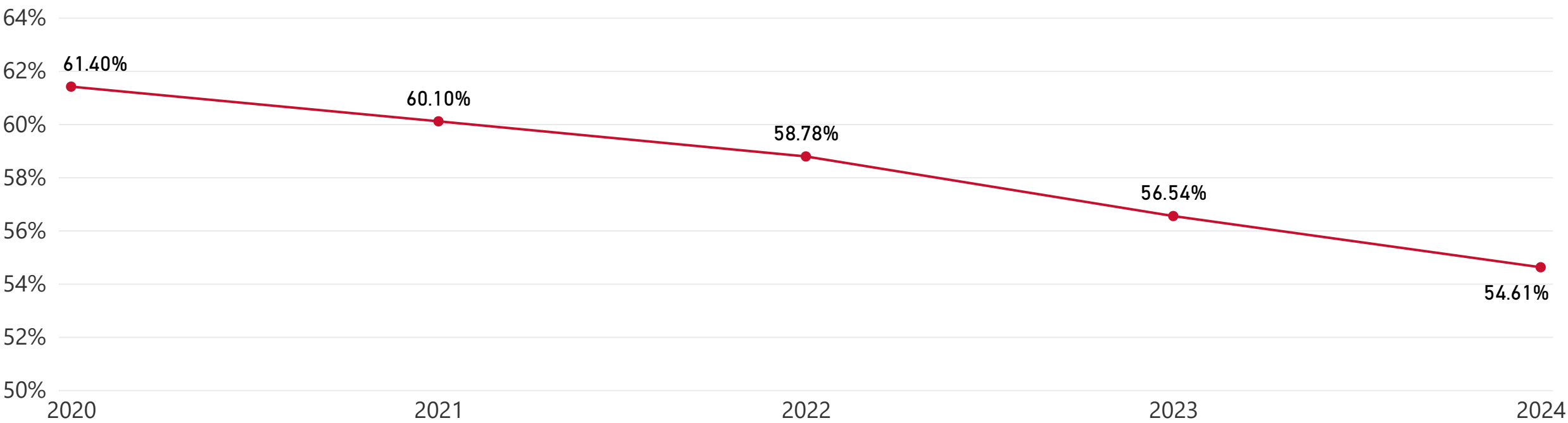

Student Population by Race / Ethnicity (Caucasian)



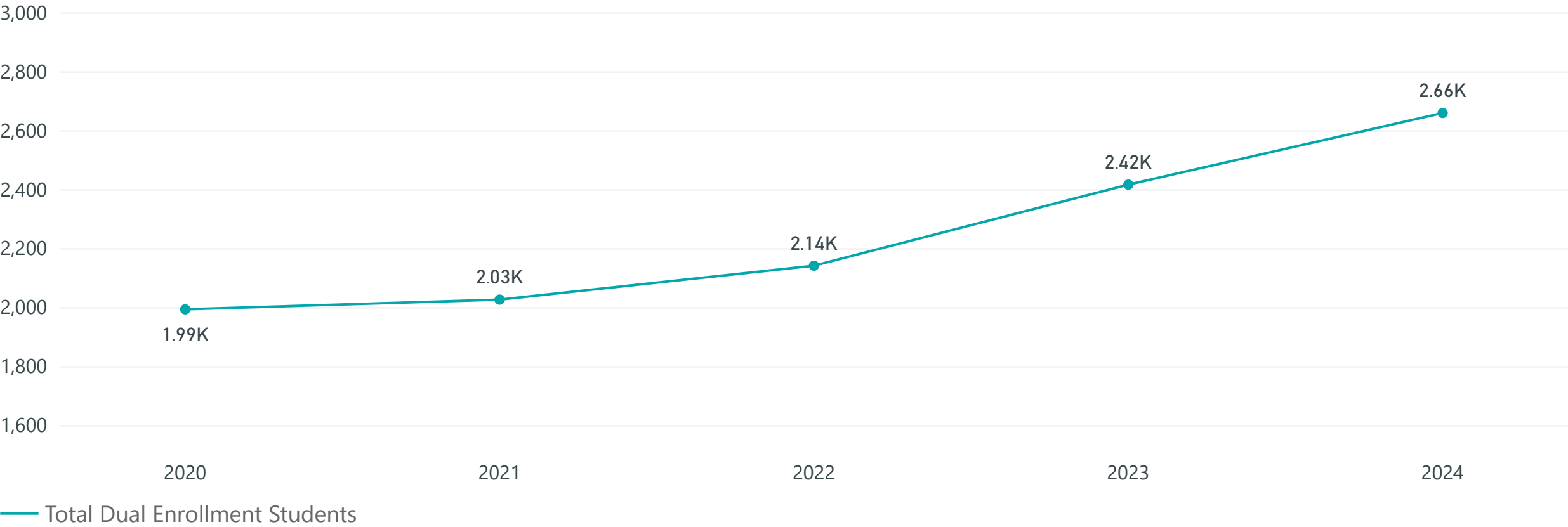

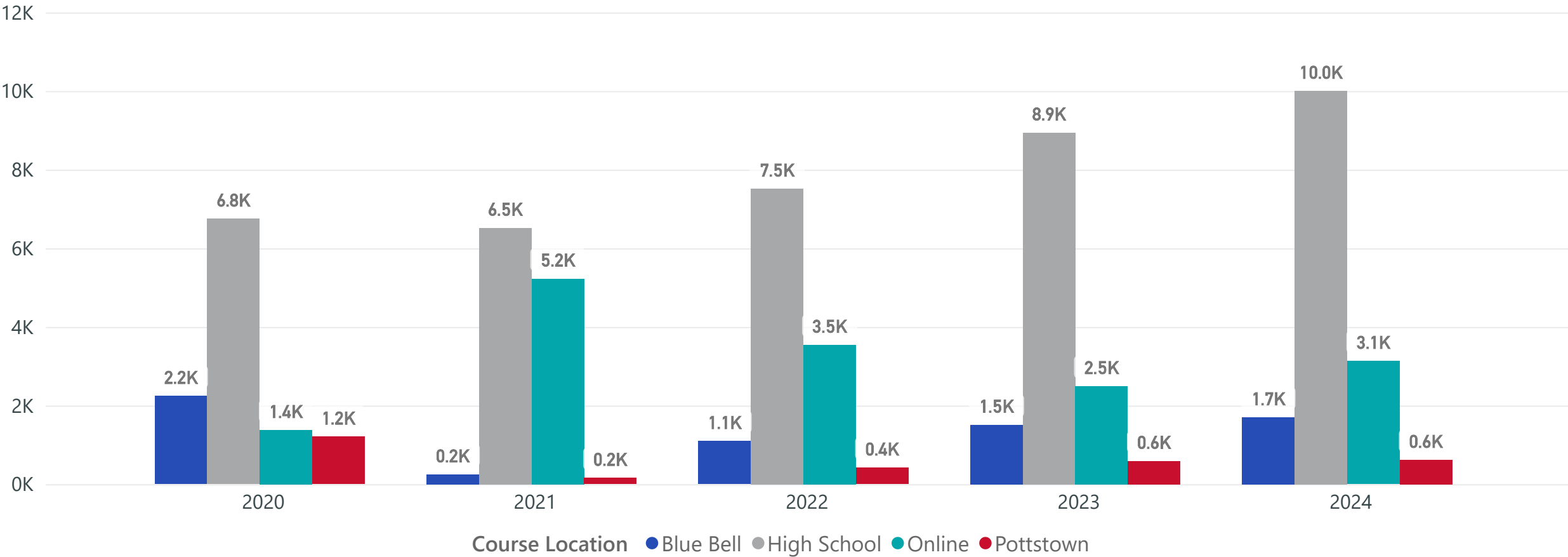
Unduplicated Headcount of Dual Enrollment (DE) Students Enrolled by Fiscal Year

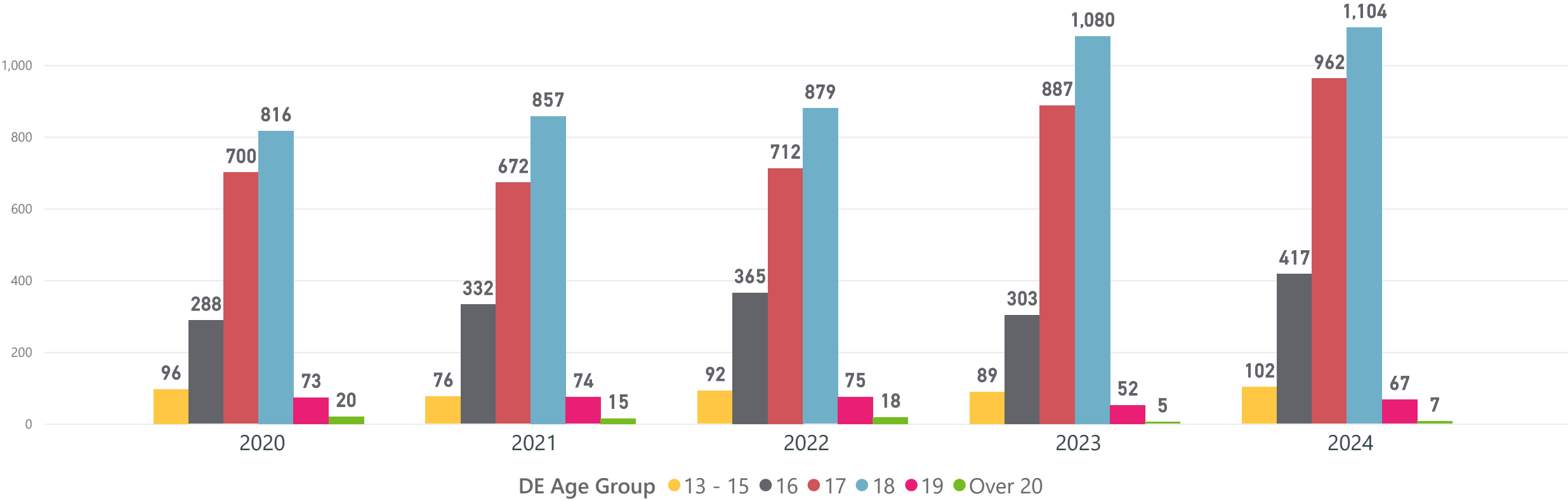

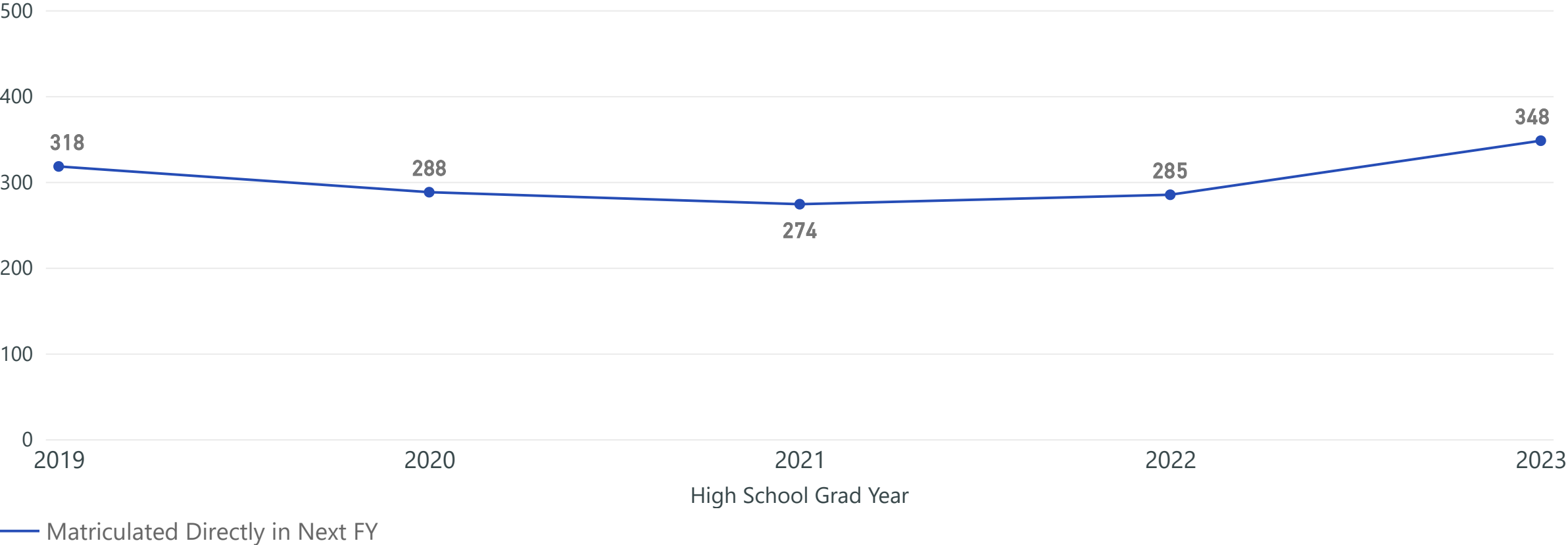

Unduplicated Headcount of Dual Enrollment (DE) Students Enrolled by Fiscal Year

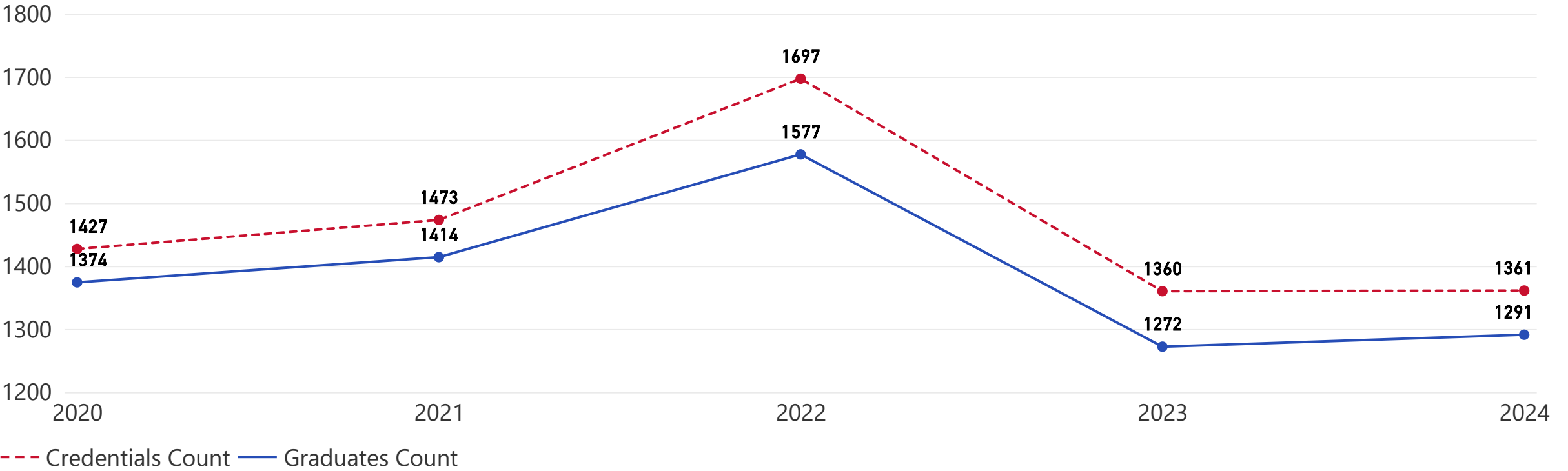

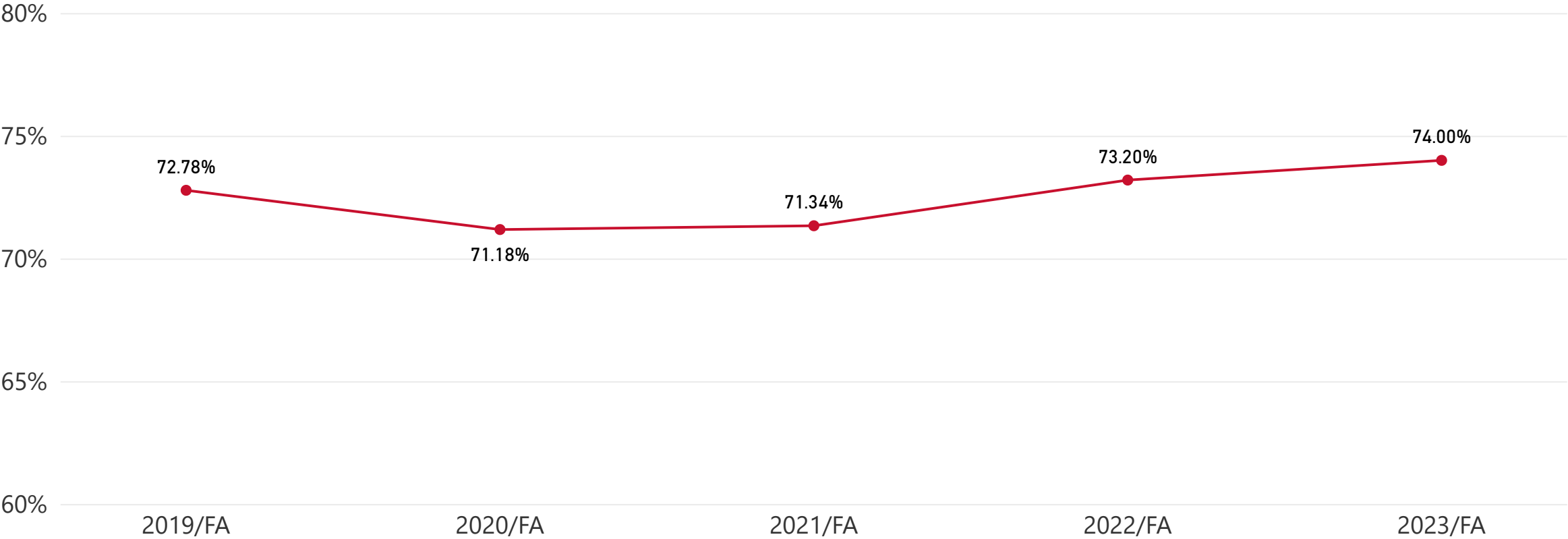

Successful Course Completion %

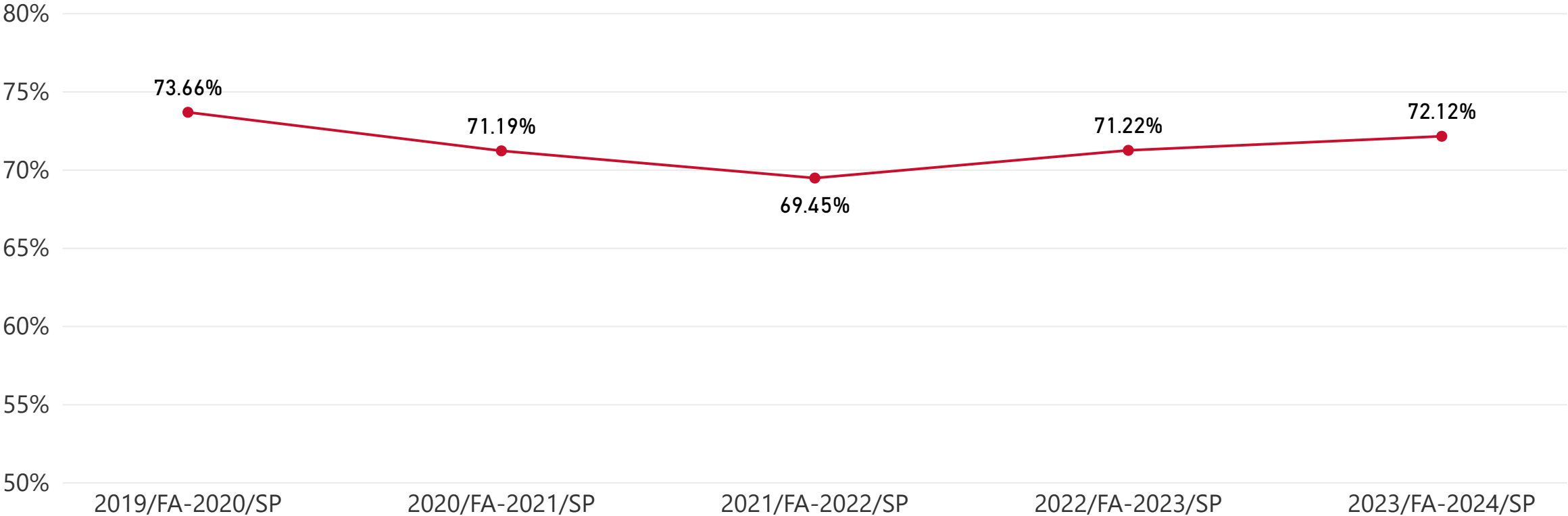

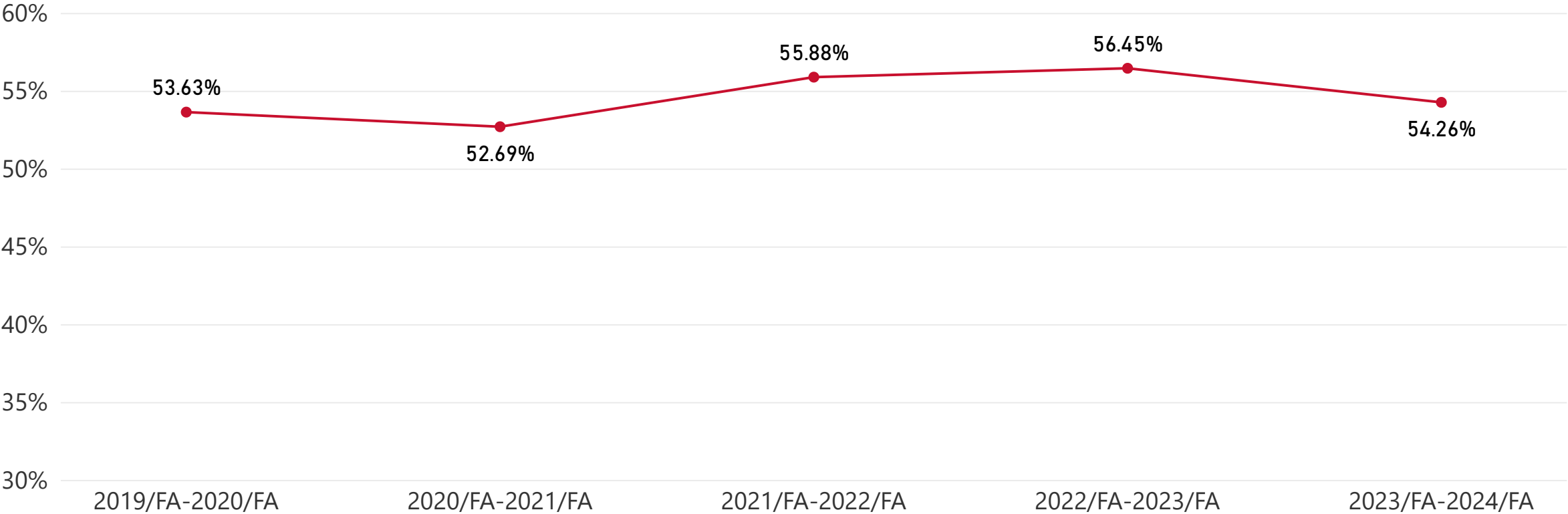
