1,366 Jobs supported


Enough to buy **1,750** new cars OR

Construction spending impact
Impact of expenditures for ongoing construction projects

\$9.9 million Added income OR **116** Jobs supported

Investment analysis

For every \$1...

Students gain **\$4.70** in lifetime earnings

Taxpayers gain **\$2.30** in added tax revenue and public sector savings

Society gains **\$9.30** in added income and social savings

The average associate degree graduate from the MCCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$12,500** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Pennsylvania.
