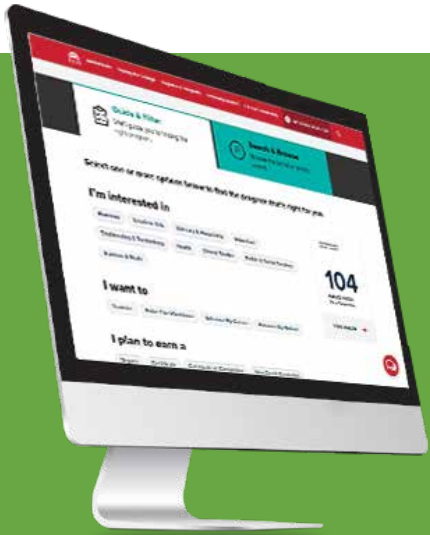

# TUITION & FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OPTIONS

If you want to attend Montco but feel overwhelmed by the cost of a college education, consider applying for financial aid. Too often students assume that they are not eligible for financial assistance, so they do not even apply for it.

## FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

Financial aid is money students (and parents) can access to help pay for college. The only way to know if you are eligible for aid is to complete the FAFSA. It costs nothing to fill out, yet the financial payoffs could be tremendous!

# HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT

## EARN UNDERGRADUATE CREDITS WHILE IN HIGH SCHOOL

Dual Enrollment allows high school students to get a head start on their college education while completing high school. Students in good academic standing with a 3.0 or higher can take college classes on campus, online or in your high school and earn undergraduate credits from Montgomery County Community College.

These credits can be transferred to a 4-year college or university or you can continue working toward a degree at Montco. Contact your intended college’s admissions office to ensure that your credits transfer completely.
