

Albright College and Montgomery County Community College Dual Admissions and Core to Core Transfer Partnership Agreement Fact Sheet

Dual Admissions: As part of the Dual Admissions Agreement, MCCC graduates are guaranteed admission into Albright College's bachelor degree programs if they:

- Have completed and submitted a Dual Admissions Intent form before completing 30 credits
- Graduate from MCCC with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) or Associate in Science (A.S.) degree
- Satisfy all Albright College transfer admission requirements

Advantages: Among the many advantages that Dual Admissions students enjoy:

- While enrolled at MCCC, full-time Dual Admissions students may take one course per year at Albright College with the tuition waived.
- Albright's Application Fee is waived for Dual Admissions candidates.
- All MCCC courses with C or better grades will transfer to Albright College.
- Full-time students entering Albright with third-year (junior) status will be able to complete a bachelor's degree within four regular terms (spring and fall) in a parallel program, provided that the student completes the appropriate Associate Degree program at MCCC and completes the appropriate sequence of courses at Albright.
- Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement: Albright College agrees to accept the general education requirements that MCCC students must complete for their Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degree. Under this agreement, MCCC's general education requirements will meet all core (General Studies) requirements for graduation from Albright, except for the foreign language requirement and the interdisciplinary studies requirement. The Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement does not alter Albright's admission standards or its requirements for various major fields of study.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

- Merit scholarships: MCCC transfer students who enroll as full-time day students at Albright College would be eligible for the following scholarship opportunities:

Scholarship	Amount per year	Applicant's GPA
Founders Scholarship	\$25,000	3.8 or higher
Presidential Scholarship	\$20,000	3.6 – 3.79
Provost's Scholarship	\$17,500	3.4 – 3.59
Alumni Scholarship	\$10,000	3.2 – 3.39
Phi Theta Kappa Members	\$5000-\$15000	3.2 or higher

All scholarships are renewable, contingent upon the student maintain the required cumulative GPA at Albright College.

- Partnership Scholarship: All MCCC adult graduates (age 23 or older) with a GPA of 2.0 or higher who enroll in Albright Colleges' Accelerated Degree Programs are eligible for a \$2500 scholarship. This will be applied to the comprehensive fee.
- Part-time students who take two Albright course per semester will receive a \$400/year scholarship.
- Evening Degree Completion students are not eligible for any merit scholarships since the tuition rate is already discounted.
- Financial aid will be awarded to Dual Admissions students on the same basis as all Albright College students. They will have equal access to Albright College grants, as well as all state and federal financial aid programs.

Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

Why does Albright College offer Dual Admissions to MCCC graduates?

Albright College is one of the a growing number of colleges and universities that have partnership agreements and dual admissions agreements with Montgomery County Community College graduates. These agreements are intended to make your transfer to a four year institution a simple process.

Do I have to attend Albright College if I sign the Intent form?

No. Signing the Intent Form simply gives you a guarantee that Albright College will admit you, as long as you meet the criteria for admissions.

If I sign the Intent Form and later apply to Albright College, do I have to attend there if I am accepted?

No. You can apply to as many colleges as you choose to apply to, but keep in mind that there is usually an application fee ranging anywhere from \$25 – 50 for each college.

Does Albright College have an accelerated bachelor degree completion program for working adults?

Yes, Albright offers five majors at various sites for adults who have at least 48 college credits. Please call 1-888-253-8851 for more details.

While attending MCCC should I keep in contact with a counselor at Albright College?

Yes, keeping in contact with a counselor at Albright, as well as your counselor or advisor at MCCC, will ensure that you take the right classes.

How do I know if I am eligible to participate in this program?

All students who graduate from MCCC with an A.A. or an A.S. degree are eligible to participate as long as you complete the Intent form before you've reached 30 credits.

How many of my MCCC courses will transfer to Albright?

Albright College agrees to accept the general education requirements that MCCC students complete for their AA or AS degree as meeting all core (general Studies) requirements except for the foreign language/cultures and the interdisciplinary studies requirements. All courses with passing grades will transfer.

What advantage is there if I sign the Intent Form?

In addition to knowing that you can transfer all of your courses for your AA or AS degree, you can one course per year FREE at Albright College if you are a full-time MCCC student.

Can I still apply for Financial Aid if I sign the Intent Form?

Yes, both full-time day MCCC students and adult students who apply to Albright College's accelerated evening degree completion program can apply for financial aid.

Where is Albright College?
