



DUAL ADMISSION & CORE TO CORE FACT SHEET

Chestnut Hill College

Chestnut Hill College, a Catholic liberal arts college in Philadelphia, PA, consists of three divisions: The School of Undergraduate Studies; the School of Continuing and Professional Studies (an evening and weekend program); and the School of Graduate Studies (advanced degree program). Some undergraduate programs are linked with graduate degrees for a combined degree program.

Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) students will be guaranteed admission into a Bachelor's degree program in the School of Undergraduate Studies or the School of Continuing and Professional Studies at Chestnut Hill College with third-year (junior) status on the condition that they:

- Complete a Dual Admissions Intent Form
- Graduate from MCCC with a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Graduate from MCCC with an Associate of Science (A.S.) or an Associate of Arts (A.A.)
- Graduate from MCCC with an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) with an established Program-to-Program agreement (*Contact CHC for details*)*
- Do not attend another institution of higher education between MCCC graduation and CHC enrollment
- Satisfy all other regular CHC admissions requirements

*Final individual course grades must be "C" or better to be considered for transfer credit to CHC

Under the **Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement**, students (A.A. and A.S.) have satisfied the core curricular requirements of CHC's School of Undergraduate Studies and School of Continuing and Professional Studies, except for six credits in religious studies to be completed at Chestnut Hill College.

DUAL ADMISSIONS

The CHC-MCCC **dual admissions program** has several advantages for transfer students:

- Application fee waiver
- Opportunities to meet with CHC academic advisors prior to graduating from MCCC in order to plan future course of study
- Scholarships/Awards and discounts may be available to MCCC graduates
