



## **Transfer Articulation Agreement Intent Form**

To be submitted to MCCC before completing 30 transferable credits

The Transfer Articulation Agreement between Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) and Delaware Valley University (DVU) is designed to allow students who complete their; Associates of Arts (A.A.), Associates of Science (A.S.) Associates of Applied Science (A.A.S.), or Associates of Fine Arts (A.F.A.) degrees at MCCC to transfer into a Bachelor's degree program at Delaware Valley University as listed in the Articulation Agreement Form.

By satisfying the conditions of this agreement (as outlined in the Transfer Articulation Agreement), the student will have the following advantages:

- Delaware Valley University's Application Fee will be waived
- Guaranteed Admission to Delaware Valley University
- Delaware Valley University's core curriculum will be waived and a maximum of 78 credits will be transferred
- Students will be eligible for completive merit based scholarships (please see reverse side for scholarship chart).

## **SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID:**

Competitive Merit Scholarships are available to Dual Admissions graduates from MCCC who enroll as full-time, degreeseeking students at Delaware Valley University, based on overall cumulative GPA at time of transfer:

Academically exemplary students who are members of the Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Honorary Society will receive a \$1,000 annual scholarship in addition to their respective Merit Scholarship Award. Please contact a Transfer Counselor regarding this award.

Please note that part-time students (enrolled in 6 to 11 credits a semester) with a final cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher will receive minimum \$3,000 a year (\$1,500 per semester).

Financial Aid will be available to Dual Admissions students on the same basis as Delaware Valley University students. They will have equal access to DVU grants, as well as state and federal financial aid programs, contingent upon successful and timely completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS & ANSWERS:	
Q. Do I have to attend DVU if I sign the Intent Form?	<b>A</b> . No. Signing the Intent Form gives you a guarantee that DVU will accept you if you follow the agreement terms.
Q. Should I keep in contact with a DVU Counselor?	<b>A</b> . Yes. Additionally, foster regular meetings with your MCCC Counselor to ensure you are taking the appropriate classes for your major at MCCC and anticipate major at DVU.
Q. How do I know if I am eligible for this program?	<b>A</b> . Please refer to the MCCC to DVU Transfer Articulation Agreement Terms and Conditions.
Q. How many of my courses will transfer to DVU?	A. Students should plan courses as outlined in transfer guides (available in MCCC's Student Success Center) and may transfer up to 78 credits into a parallel bachelor's degree program (minimum grade of C or higher)
Q. Will a grade of "D" transfer to DVU?	<b>A.</b> A grade of "D" in the first of a course sequence will transfer if a grade of "C" or higher is earned in the second course. A grade of "D" in stand alone course will transfer as elective credit.
Q. Where is Delaware Valley University?	A. DVU is conveniently located in Doylestown, in Bucks County
