

Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) and DeSales University (DSU) Dual Admissions Intent Form

Completion of this Dual Admissions Intent form entitles you to be admitted into a Bachelor’s degree program with junior status at DeSales University provided that you:

- Complete this form in accordance with DeSales University admissions requirements. For students applying to the traditional program, this form should be completed at least one year prior to your intended start date at DSU. Non-traditional (ACCESS) students applying to DSU through the ACCESS Program should apply *at least* one session (8 weeks) prior to their intended start date.

- Graduate from MCCC with an A.A. or A.S. degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for courses required in and offered by the major at DSU, with the exception of those programs that require a higher G.P.A. (e.g. Education 3.0). Students with an A.A.S. or A.G.S. degree may still participate in the dual admissions agreement and will have transcripts evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

- Satisfy all other DeSales University transfer and admission requirements.
