- Graduate from MCCC with an A.A. or A.S. degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for courses required in and offered by the major at DSU, with the exception of those programs that require a higher G.P.A. (e.g. Education 3.0). Students with an A.A.S. or A.G.S. degree may still participate in the dual admissions agreement and will have transcripts evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
- Satisfy all other DeSales University transfer and admission requirements.
