Dual Admissions Intent Form**

Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) and Gwynedd Mercy University (GMercyU) enter into this Dual Admission Agreement so that MCCC students admitted into an Associate of Arts (A.A.), Associate of Science (A.S.), or Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree program at MCCC will be admitted into a bachelor's degree program at GMercyU. International students (FI VISA) also are very welcome at GMercyU.

As an MCCC student, you will be accepted to GMercyU provided that you:

- Graduate from MCCC with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0; a higher GPA may be required for individual programs as outlined in the Partnership Agreement
- Enroll at GMercyU within one year of MCCC graduation
- Do not attend another institution of higher education between the time you graduate from MCCC and enroll at GMercyU
- Complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form before graduating from MCCC
- **Satisfy all GMercyU admissions requirements including**
  - **Completing a free online admissions application at gmercyu.edu**
  - **Submitting official copies of all college transcripts from every institution attended (MCCC will provide your MCCC transcripts to GMercyU once you complete this form. Transcripts from other schools must be submitted directly to Gwynedd Mercy University.)**

Once you have satisfied these conditions, you will be eligible for:

- An annual academic merit scholarship ranging from \$10,000 to \$17,000, provided you graduated from MCCC with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- A free transcript evaluation that outlines which credits will transfer in to your major of choice
- An opportunity to meet with a trained GMercyU transfer admissions counselor who will assist you in transferring to a bachelor's degree program at GMercyU
- Invitations to relevant programs and open house events
- Priority consideration for institutional, federal, state, and other sources of financial aid

You may void this agreement at any time with written notification to MCCC and GMercyU.

GMercyU welcomes transfer students from Montgomery County Community College through the **Dual Admissions and Core-to Core Transfer Agreements**. With an 11 to 1 student-faculty ratio and a reputation for helping students achieve their personal and professional goals, GMercyU is committed to helping you maximize the value of your GMercyU education. The **Core-to Core Transfer Agreement** allows MCCC students who have completed an A.A., A.S., or one of the specified A.A.S. degrees to enter GMercyU having satisfied most of GMercyU's general education requirements. ### **Eligibility for Dual Admissions:**

Students who are currently enrolled or recently graduated from MCCC may apply for acceptance into the Dual Admissions Program by completing the Dual Admissions Intent Form, submitting an online GMercyU admissions application, and providing official copies of transcripts for all colleges attended.

The Dual Admissions Intent form should be returned to the Office of Admission and Records at MCCC College Hall, Central Campus or Room 151 at the West Campus. Please refer to the MCCC & Gwynedd Mercy University Dual Admissions Intent Form for the specific conditions of dual admissions.

### **Scholarship and Grant Opportunities:**

Awards are available to students enrolling on a full-time basis at GMercyU and are renewable for up to three years by maintaining the minimum GPA specified below.

- \$10,000 academic grant to students with final 2.5-2.99 cumulative GPA
- \$12,000 academic scholarship to students with final 3.0-3.49 cumulative GPA
- \$15,000 academic scholarship to students with final 3.5 cumulative GPA or higher
- \$2,000 scholarship for active members of Phi Theta Kappa

Our Financial Aid Office will help you complete your Federal and State Grant applications. Personal appointments with our Financial Aid Office are encouraged.
