How to Record Using Lecture Tool



Step 1: Tap the Lecture Tool icon






to show what structures you are tapping on.




Step 2: Single tap the Recording icon






Step 3: Toggle the microphone and camera on/off based on your recording preferences.




Step 4: Once ready to record, tap on the Record icon to begin recording. To pause the lecture, tap on the Pause icon. When finished recording, press the Stop icon.

Note: When recording, you may exit out of the Lecture Tool menu. The recording will continue to run until reopening the menu and stopping the recording.



Step 5: Once the recording is stopped, export the recording to your PC or upload to

a USB drive as an .ltv file by tapping on the Export icon



How to Playback Recordings

Step 1: Tap on the Lecture Tool icon




and then tap on the Playback icon






. Then locate and select the .ltv file. Step 2: Tap on the Import icon



Step 4: Tap on the Play icon to playback the recording.
