***Expectations for Students and Tutors***

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will be served in the order they sign into the Waiting Room. If not present when the Tutor becomes available, the next in line will be served.</li><li>• Ask questions and engage in relevant discussions with the tutor.</li><li>• Pose questions based on problems or material that you have reviewed and studied prior to the tutoring session.</li><li>• Have an open mind, a positive attitude, and a willingness to work.</li><li>• Tutoring sessions are not a replacement for attending class — <u>Attend class regularly.</u></li><li>• Always attempt the work prior to the tutoring session. Bring in all attempted work to aid the tutor in helping you. Avoid bringing in blank assignments.</li><li>• Come prepared with your papers, notes, books, assignments, and other learning materials.</li><li>• Be respectful. Use appropriate language and exercise patience.</li><li>• Pay close attention to the tutors and be mindful of their time. Tutoring sessions are typically 30 minutes in length.</li><li>• Tutors are not permitted to complete assignments, quizzes, exams or papers with or for students.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tutors will serve students in the order in which they signed into the Waiting Room.</li><li>• Set clear expectations about the tutoring session and answer questions to the best of your ability, engaging in relevant discussion with the student.</li><li>• Be knowledgeable about resources available to help students.</li><li>• Have an open mind, a positive attitude, and a willingness to help students from diverse backgrounds and with different learning styles.</li><li>• If there is a conflict between the student and an instructor, remain understanding yet neutral. Remind the student of appropriate channels to reach a resolution and help the student to refocus on the session.</li><li>• Be respectful. Use appropriate language and exercise patience.</li><li>• Pay close attention to students and be mindful of their time. Tutoring sessions are typically 30 minutes in length.</li><li>• Tutors help students learn by fostering independent learning. They are not permitted to do students' work.</li></ul>
