## Montgomery County Community College ART 201 Illustration I 3-2-2

#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A special study in illustration techniques intended to develop both the drawing and design skills needed to work in commercial art. Students will become familiar with a wide range of materials and techniques. The fundamentals of illustration will be explored while challenging the students' imagination and expanding their creative skills. The primary emphasis will be placed on introducing new media and techniques while developing the students' skills in finding creative solutions to visual problems.
