Nursing Program Outcomes

The Nursing Program is proud to share the following Program Outcomes to reinforce the Program's dedication to meeting the needs of the Nursing Profession.

Program Outcome 1- NCLEX- RN first time pass rates- Annual pass rate for first time candidates on NCLEX-RN will be at or above the national mean. Estimated Level of Achievement- 80% First time Pass Rate. Reporting cycle- October 1- September 30th.

Program Outcome 2-

2020-2022: Program Completion rates-ELOA- 65% of students who enter the nursing program will complete the program within 150% of program length, 6 semesters. Reporting cycle- first nursing course through graduation.

2022- 2024 Program Completion rates-ELOA- 65% of students who enter the nursing program will complete the program within 100% of program length, 5 semesters. Reporting cycle- first nursing course through graduation.

Program Outcome 3- Employment rate- ELOA- 80% of Respondents to the *Nursing Program Graduate Survey* are employed 6 months following graduation. According to returned Graduate Surveys, the employment rate at 6 months ranges from 80-90%
