





EXPLORE YOUR FINANCIAL AID OPTIONS

GRANTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS — MONEY YOU DON'T HAVE TO PAY BACK

Applying for financial aid via the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) allows you to be considered for federal, state, and institutional financial aid funding.

- Federal Grants federal financial aid such as the PELL grant
- + State Grants state financial aid such as the PHEAA State Grant awards
- + Scholarships institutional financial aid that does not need to be repaid (scholarship application opens June 15)

LOANS – BORROWED MONEY THAT MUST BE REPAID WITH INTEREST

- + Federal Direct Loans low-interest loans such as subsidized, unsubsidized and Parent PLUS. Complete your Master Promissory Note (MPN) and entrance counseling at studentaid.gov.
- Private Education Loans loans offered by private lenders that help bridge the gap between actual educational costs and financial aid awards



APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

STEP 1: Obtain your FSA ID at mc3.edu/fsaid.

STEP 2: Fill out the Free
Application for Federal Student Aid
(FAFSA). Learn more at mc3.edu/fsaid.

- Montco offers financial aid appointments to help you navigate the form. Sign up at mc3.edu/fahelp.
- + Montco's Federal School Code is **004452**.

STEP 3: Apply for a PHEAA State Grant or Loan at pheaa.org.

IMPORTANT DATES

All dates are the "year prior" to the academic year for which you will be attending.

OCTOBER 1

Students can file the FAFSA as early as October 1 of the year prior.

MAY 1

If you're a Pennsylvania resident, complete the FAFSA before May 1 to meet the PHEAA State Grant filing deadline.

JULY 15

Submit your online scholarship application at mc3.edu/scholarships by July 15 for priority consideration.

(Note: Students must be registered for the upcoming fall semester to be eligible).



TAP INTO OTHER FINANCIAL RESOURCES

529 Savings Program

The 529 Savings Program is a college savings plan that offers tax benefits. It can be used to cover your education costs. Be sure to request your funds as soon as you are registered for classes and forward your confirmation to payment@mc3.edu.

Federal Work Study — Part-time Employment

Federal work study is need-based financial aid for part-time employment made available to help students finance the costs of college. You must file the FAFSA to be eligible. Visit **mc3.edu/workstudy** for more information.

Veterans Benefits

Employer Tuition Assistance Program

In collaboration with your HR representative, or your parent/guardian's employer, submit an employer voucher for review to payment@mc3.edu.


Outside Scholarships

If you have earned a scholarship outside of Montco, submit your scholarship information to **FA@mc3.edu** and **payment@mc3.edu**.

Prior Learning Assessment (PLA)

If you have experience in the workforce or military, you may be eligible to earn credits for courses in which you can demonstrate mastery of the material. Learn more at mc3.edu/PLA.

PAYING FOR BOOKS — PLAN AHEAD!



Don't let the cost of books get in the way of your education. You may be eligible to receive a financial aid

Payment Plans

Off-set your out-of-pocket expenses with a payment plan. 
How to Pay
